

# Ptm Project Connector

This connector allows **projects** to be exported to a file or imported from a file. The following fields should be mapped and connected:

<b>\$parentProjectCode</b>	Code of the parent project
<b>\$structure</b>	Project Structure to which the imported/exported project is/shall be assigned
<b>\$this</b>	this option is developer-specific and currently not available for the standard administrator/user
<b>\$type</b>	Element type of the project that is imported/exported
<i>_importance</i>	Possibility to insert information of configurable attributes (e.g. importance, cost factor, coffee break, etc...). The underscore character _ in before the text indicates that this is a freely selectable attribute.
<i>_coffee break</i>	--- // ---
<i>_comment</i>	--- // ---
<b>allCustomersOfClientSelectable</b>	true/false: are all customers of the respective client selectable to be assigned to this project?
<b>bookable</b>	true/false: Is the project bookable?
<b>chargeable</b>	true/false: Can efforts for this project be marked as chargeable?
<b>code</b>	Project Code
<b>description</b>	space for a detailed description of the project
<b>effortChargeableByDefault</b>	true/false: are efforts for this project marked as chargeable by default?
<b>name</b>	Name of the project
<b>plannedEffort</b>	planned & allocated hours of effort for this project
<b>shortName</b>	Short name of the project
<b>totalPlannedEffort</b>	planned & allocated hpurs of effort for this project including all its sub-projects
<b>validfrom</b>	date - project valid from
<b>validto</b>	date - project valid to
