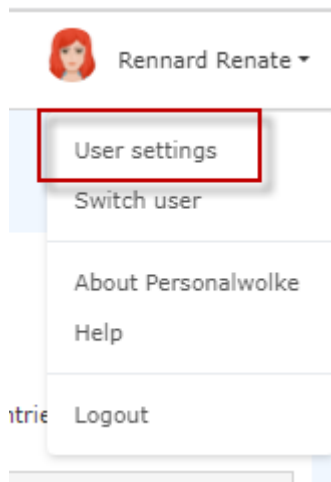


2-Faktor-Authentification

To set the 2-factor authentication, the employee must go to the profile settings on the start page (click on the avatar or name in the upper right corner of the start page, see picture).
