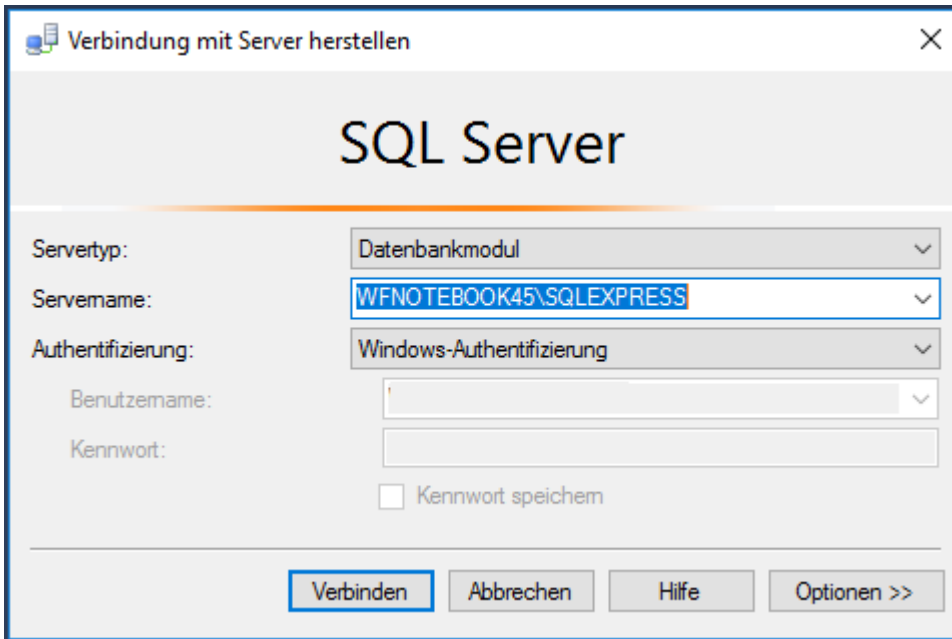

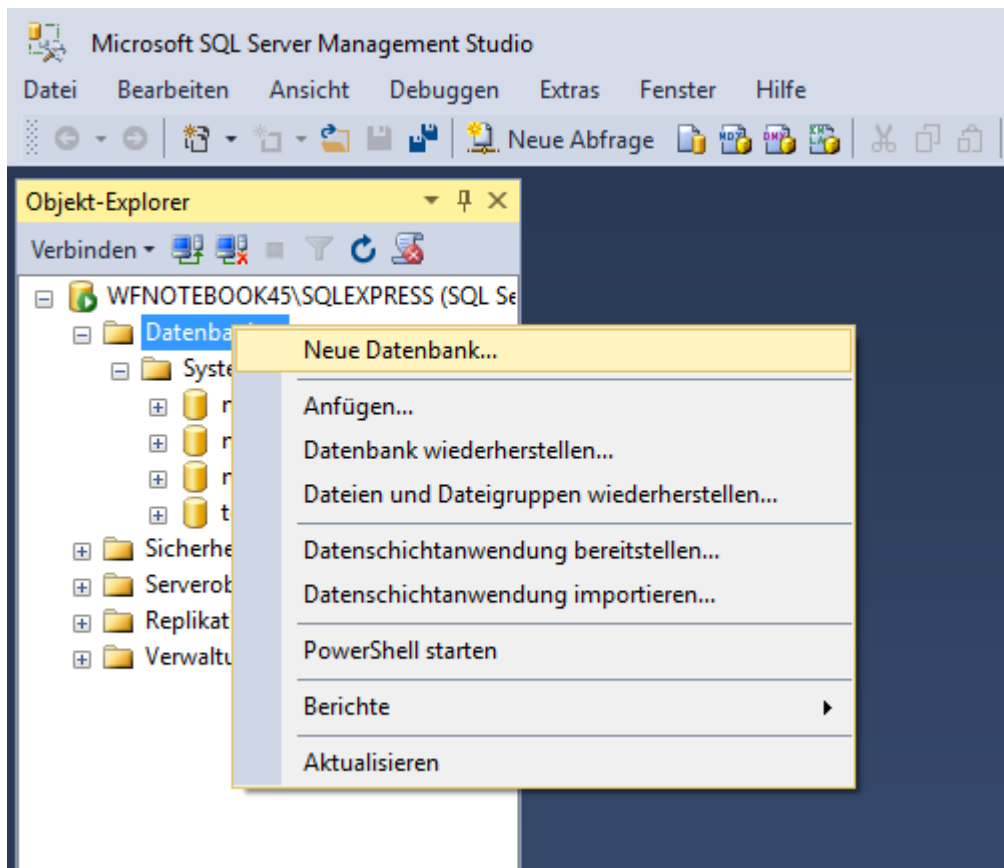
Open SQL Management Konsole

Connect to SQLEXPRESS using Windows authentication.



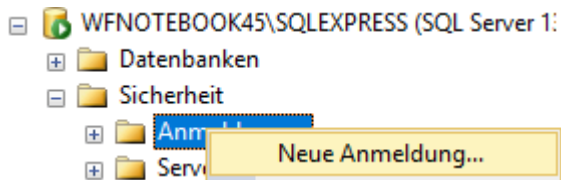
Collapse the Server
